## 4NT is Blackwood

the responses to the 4 NT ask are: -

| 5* | 0 or 4 aces |
| :---: | :---: |
| 5 | 1 ace |
| 5 | 2 aces |
| 5ヵ | 3 aces |

and if the asker is interested in a grand slam, he may ask for kings with 5 NT : -
the responses to the 5 NT ask are: -

& 5 \boldsymbol{*}=0 \text { or } 4 \text { kings } \\
& 5=1 \text { king } \\
& 5 \\
& 5 \uparrow=3 \text { kings } \\

\end{aligned}
$$

One normally only asks for kings if all of the aces are present.

## 4* is Blackwood

the responses to the $4 \%$ ask are: -
4 - $\quad 0$ or 4 aces
$4 \vee=1$ ace
$4 \boldsymbol{\wedge}=2$ aces
$4 \mathrm{NT}=3$ aces
Note that after the response is given, a 4NT bid by asker is to play. If the asker is interested in a grand slam he may asks for kings with 5 a:-
the responses to the $5 \%$ ask are: -

\begin{aligned}
& 5=0 \text { or } 4 \text { kings } \\
& 5=1 \text { king } \\
& 5 \uparrow=2 \text { kings } \\
& 5 N T=3 \text { kings }
\end{aligned}
$$

Again one normally only asks for kings if all of the aces are present.
