JACOBY 2NT

After an opening of $1 \checkmark / \spadesuit$, a bid of 2NT is 12+ pts (no upper limit), showing a 4 card fit and investigates slam.

The Opener replies as follows:

$$3 \clubsuit$$
= \clubsuit shortage $4 \clubsuit$ = a 5-card suit $3 \spadesuit$ = \spadesuit shortage $4 \spadesuit$ = a 5 card suit 3 other major = shortage $4 \spadesuit$ (if \spadesuit 's bid)= a 5-card suit

With no shortage or 2nd suit, the opener replies as follows:

3 of the major : encouraging 3 NT : average 4 of the major : discouraging

Some people play the jump shift to show a void, but you can do that by subsequently cue bidding the suit. So showing a 2^{nd} suit (a potential source of tricks) is the most popular treatment.
